"I said 'yes'," Jenn explains. "I remember working at one woman's house on Grand Avenue—I was weeding and Zinnia sat down on the swing with her and chatted away. It was especially sweet to see them enjoying each other's company. So Service Saturdays became our tradition."

Now Jenn Lukesh is the board treasurer for North Fork Senior Connections and Zinnia is almost ten. She still loves participating in Service Saturdays. "I like feeling like I help seniors and make their home a more beautiful place to live." Zinnia smiles. "I really liked pulling up the plant part of the tulips—it makes a satisfying popping sound."

"Volunteering is a wonderful way to connect to the community," says Jenn. "It also gives kids an opportunity to see that their contribution makes a difference. My hope is that we can attract more families with kids and create more opportunities for cross-generational connections and benefits."
